ALLIANCE OF NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS DEDICATED TO SAFE AND HEALTHY STUDENTS DEMAND ACTION TO ENSURE STUDENTS ARE SAFE FROM GUN VIOLENCE

June 2, 2022 - Washington DC—The undersigned members of the <u>Title IV-A Coalition</u>—a group of national organizations dedicated to improving student wellness and ensuring all schools are safe, healthy, and engaging spaces with access to well-rounded enriching education programs—demand meaningful Congressional action to prevent future acts of gun violence. We share in the profound grief and anger regarding the school shooting in Uvalde, Texas. These events are far too common and we urge policymakers at all levels to come together to enact meaningful gun safety policies that will prevent these horrific events from happening again.

Since the devastating school shooting at Sandy Hook Elementary School, there have been 948 school shootings and over 3,000 events of mass community violence. In contrast, there have been zero major policies to prevent gun violence enacted at the federal level. Firearms are now the leading cause of death for children in the United States. Yet, despite overwhelming public opinion and repeated calls for action, Congress has shamefully abdicated their responsibility to protect its most vulnerable citizens, our children.

Will this time be different? Act now. Our children's lives and our country's future depends on it.
